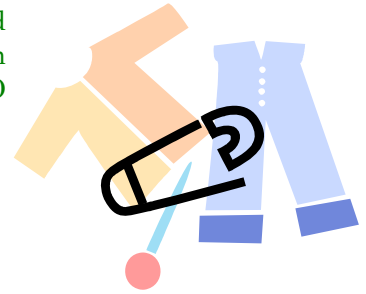

In an effort to improve communication in our school community and to help keep Chinthurst up-to-date with the ever changing demands of technology, we will be introducing a very clever (but easy to use) text messaging service. This will be particularly useful when there are unscheduled changes, cancellations or urgent and important information regarding your son,

that need to be delivered in a timely manner.

With regards to specific sporting teams you will be able to attach your number to the teams your child is involved in. In the New Year, you will be able to do this by clicking on the text messaging link on the Chinthurst website. For sporting teams and groups the cost of sending/receiving a message will be carried by the receiver so it will be your choice to opt-in and out as you wish.

It is important to understand that the school will have com-

plete control over the sending of messages, and will only send a message out when there are last minute schedule changes and important information that affect your child.

While this service is not compulsory and you will have the ability to opt-in and out as you please, we will be encouraging you to use the service to ensure it can be utilised to its full potential. Live links have been placed on the school website over the weekend, containing details of how to sign up to the scheme.
